Think about **everything that identifies you**, legally and in terms of your tastes, your interests and your personality, things about you that make you unique. Using all this information, create your own 'identity card'.

1. On one side, write down the **personal and legal information** you want on your card (name, address, family etc.). Leave a space to **draw your portrait** (photo), it can be a 'realistic' drawing or a portrait that represents or identifies you. Remember, it's your card and you can design it any way you like.

2. On the other side, put the information that you would like to appear on your identity card that **identifies you as a unique person on this planet**.



Share your identity card with the others and listen carefully to what identifies each one of them: the things they are passionate about and what they want to be recognised for. Then, create a two-sided **Tapori identity card** for your group.

1. On one side, write all the **'legal' information about your group**: name, number of members, year the group was created, facilitators, etc. Why you think your Tapori group exists.

2. On the other side of the card, write down the **particular features that set your group apart**. To do this, listen to each other and agree before writing them down. What makes your group unique? What enables a Tapori group to exist? What can't be left out?

3. A photo of your group. Once you agree on all of this, what photo would represent your group? What represents you, what unites you?

You can now create a 'group card'- so get to work!
